How much do lessons cost?

Where do lessons and courses take place?

Lessons take place in your home or your office or in a suitable place in Zurich city. If your home or office is outside of Zurich city, then a travel fee may apply.

How long do lessons last?

Our lessons last **60 or 90 minutes**. Experience has shown that 90 minutes is an optimal length for maximum progress.

When can I start with my lessons or course?

For one-on-one lessons you can start any time! If you wish to join a group then it depends on demand and will be decided after assessment.

What is your cancellation policy?

For individually scheduled lessons the following applies: If you cancel a lesson **24 hours** or less before the start, you will be charged for the full lesson.

For group courses booked and paid in advance (i.e. packages of 10 or 20 lessons), individual participants are not reimbursed for missed lessons or if they choose to opt out.

When and how do I pay?
